She has always been involved in many activities at school and in her community. At the age of three, Maci







Park Winkler put the final touches on the 2023 baseball season by being selected to the area all-star team, having put up numbers during his most recent campaign that would have made any twelve-year-old proud. Not bad for an 8-year-old! The youngest of the three sons of Stacy and Dr. John Winkler, Park has grown up as part of an athletic brood and has long been accustomed to battling older competitors right there on the pitch in his own backyard, driveway court, or the adjacent Cobb course.

His team's record the past two seasons is an impressive 28-1, and Park has been a major contributor whether he's on the mound mowing down opposing hitters, fielding grounders at second base, or hammering balls all over the park at the plate.


As his team's ace this year Park went 8-0 and 5 of the 8Ws were combined no-hitters! The fireballer struck out 53% of the hitters he faced this season. That's 70Ks out of 133 batters faced! Impressed? Chew on this stat: Park had two innings where he only needed 10 pitches to strike out the entire side

and both of those instances were 9 strikes and a foul ball. Talk about serving them up and setting them down!

He was just as formidable at the plate, hitting at a .548 clip with an on-base percentage of .674. His 17 hits produced 14 RBIs, and he touched home 24 times while only fanning 4 times himself. Those are all-star stats and resulted in his being included on the all-star team, which is usually only made up of eleven- and twelve-year-olds.

Don't let Park's soft-spoken persona off the field mislead you, he is the ultimate competitor whether it is sports, a friendly game of chess, or a board game. The little brother of Drew and Grant does not like to lose. So much so, he wears #24 in honor of Kobe Bryant. The "Black Mamba" was known as a fierce competitor who hated losing. Park's motor runs hot. He recently told his father that his goal this summer is to do 100 pushups and 100 sit-ups every day this summer. So far the goal is intact.

His coaches say he is extremely coachable and willing to do whatever they ask him to do. Park is a good teammate and roots for his buddies, always encouraging them to give their best. If you see him about this summer (clue: he's a regular on the driving range!), ask him how all-stars turned out and if his streak of exercising every day is still going!

Specifically, the framing of the home which was designed and produced by Riverbend Timberframing and erected by Tim Hill. The great room is open concept, with 20ft high ceilings and adorned with the aforementioned white oak timber beams that make up the framing of the home.

The residence is situated between three (3) levels, the top being a loft style office space which opens up to the residence's great room. Off the kitchen, a private sun room provides the ideal location to enjoy all the beauty of the Wild and Wonderful West Virginia landscape from the comfort of ones home. Other features include: two (2) master bedrooms (one on both the main and basement levels of the home), an oversized master bathroom, private office space, newly refinished white oak floors and custom maple, quarter sawn oak and hickory cabinetry which have been installed throughout.

From the lower level of the home there is access to a private porch, and a path which leads to a fire pit overlooking Chatham Lake. This level includes twelve (12ft) ceilings and incorporates a nine hundred (900) square feet storage area and a kitchenette. Many of the rooms of the home can be handicap accessible, including the downstairs bathroom which includes an extra large walk in shower and handicap accessible vanity. In addition all of the doors in the home range from 32'- 36' wide.

From the main area of the home, one can access the spacious garage (23ft x 28 ft!) by way of a breezeway that seamlessly connects the two. The flooring which runs concurrently between the home and garage is level and covered, providing shelter from the elements year round. The oversized garage can even hold two (2) cars, a golf cart and work bench comfortably with room to spare.

The home also hosts a whole house vacuum system, PEX water lines which allow you to turn water off/on to any faucet/appliance in the house, structural insulated panel systems (SIPS), PELLA windows and doors, and much, much more.



Cushmans challenge other fireworks lovers to make a difference!

very mother, every father knows the gravity and unpredictability of parenting. We all hope the decisions we make in child-rearing and that the love and sacrifice we invest freely in our children works out for the best. Few things can make a parent more proud or more fulfilled than seeing their grown children succeed both professionally and in their personal lives as spouses, partners, and parents themselves. Sherry and Tom Cushman know that satisfaction, having two adult daughters and a bevy of grandchildren that keep things hopping around their lake home on Chatham.

On June 6, 1999, the Cushmans' son Miles was injured in a car accident during his senior year at Virginia Tech, leaving Miles permanently disabled with a traumatic brain injury. Sherry and Tom immediately doubled down on their responsibility as parents. The love and sacrifice given endlessly in caring for Miles since the accident has been evident to friends and neighbors for 24 years now. Miles's journey has seen many challenges, valleys with struggles and hospitalizations and infections that have taxed both Miles and his mom and dad, but there have also been bright days and victories in the face of overwhelming odds. Miles has come through five major surgeries to compete successfully in track meets and golf tournaments for challenged athletes. Days are not predictable. Some days communication is difficult, or balance may be affected. Appetite comes and goes; currently Miles is using a feeding tube to assist with nutritional intake.

Through it all, the constant has been love in the form of patience, sleep deprivation, hours of therapy and prayer, and an almost 24-7 vigil. Through all the hard work and sacrifice they have maintained a positivity that has sustained one another, Miles, their own extended family, friends, and other families who have found themselves caring for a loved one who has suffered a traumatic brain injury.

Not content with just providing care and a quality of life for Miles, the Cushmans joined with two other Beckley area families to create a brain injury support group here in Raleigh County. The monthly meeting is a great connection for TBI caregivers. The group is led by licensed social worker Shannon Hughart and Teresa Harvey, the mother of a TBI survivor. Membership has vacillated over the years, sometimes with as many as 15 families. The current group usually has 5 or 6 at a gathering where they share issues they may be facing and how they might address problems they are facing. Tom says, "One of the best things is just realizing that you are not alone. Others have gone through or are going through what you may be struggling with."


"Many in the group have learned that shifts in barometric pressure cause headaches, which can be reassuring," Sherry notes, "because you always fear for the worst." The group has introduced



members to the Center for Excellence in Disabilities located in Morgantown. The center is often helpful in assisting TBI victims and their families obtain needed equipment.

In recent years, the Cushmans have established a fund through the Beckley Area Foundation in the name of the Brain Injury Support Group of Southern WV. The goal is to assist organizations or individuals who may be caring for those suffering from TBI. It has become somewhat of a Chatham tradition that Tom and son-in-law Scott Wilks conduct a fireworks display on July 4th for neighbors and Glade residents who like to come for the show. Many who







enjoyed the fireworks have asked if they could help with the expense. Tom has a ready response: "You sure can! Make a donation to BAF and specify to the Brain Injury Support Group of So. WV!"

So, there you have it. If you like fireworks and you would like to help a couple of real difference makers like Sherry and Tom Cushman continue to make a difference, donate to the BAF foundation (Brain Injury Fund) to make a difference yourself in the lives of those who are struggling to provide care to a loved one suffering from TBI.



This recipe started with a conversation about Pat's and Geno's (I'm from South Central Pennsylvania) with Shane, Cindy and myself and we decided to try a copycat version.

Nautical Nostalgia

these step-by-step instructions for picture frames that will beautifully

As the summer sun begins to set and memories of travels far and wide linger, it's the perfect time to capture those moments with a personalized end-ofsummer project. Whether you choose vibrant colors or natural hues, handpicked shells or carefully selected store-bought ones, this seashell-adorned picture frame offers endless possibilities for customization, showcasing cherished summer remembrances in a frame that reflects your own unique style.

Materials

- Shells (a few large and many smaller ones - whatever shape or color desired)
- Plain wooden picture frame (in your preferred size)
- Hot glue gun or tacky glue
- · Acrylic craft paint (in your preferred color for the frame) and paintbrush
- Newspaper or other protection for work surface

Optional

- Fake pearls
- Glitter
- Pebbles
- Sea glass

Steps

- 1/ Prepare the crafting area with newspaper. Be sure to remove glass and backing from the frame before beginning.
- 2 / Using acrylic craft paint and brush, paint one side of the frame. Allow it to dry completely before flipping it over and painting the

- other side. If needed, apply an additional layer of paint to the frame to achieve the desired effect. You also may choose to paint some or all of the shells for an extra touch of creativity.
- 3 / Once the paint has dried, play around with different arrangements of shells on the frame. Shells can be organized randomly or in a pattern, overlapping or not. Smaller shells, pearls, pebbles and other optional materials can fill the gaps between larger shells.
- 4 / When you find a composition you like, begin gluing the shells onto the frame, starting with the largest ones. Only apply glue to the parts of the shell that will be touching the frame. Let the glue dry for a few hours or overnight.
- **5** / Replace the backing and glass on the frame, put a memorable photo inside, and enjoy!
