Retired Beckley businessman David Mankin finds Glade Springs living today even more attractive than when his wife casually quipped on their first drive through the property back in 1989, "I'd take that house." Thirty-three years later, Mankin is still in love with that house, which became a home for him and wife Peggy (now four years deceased) and their three children, sons Matt and JW and daughter Kelly. Just off Lake Drive and adjacent to hole No. 10 of The Cobb, Mankin uses the sunniest portion of the property to

grow tomatoes for his four granddaughters. "Initially, we were looking for a farm property. Really, we just wanted to get off Route 3 in Shady Spring. We had numerous car wrecks that ended up in our front yard, and Peggy was rear-ended trying to turn into our driveway," Mankin recalled recently while logs crackled warmly from a fire in the big living room fireplace. He now lives mainly on the first floor, keeping the second floor of the brick home always ready to welcome children and grandkids who now live in other states. "It's just home," he sighs contentedly.

He stays busy these days doing yard work and landscaping and doing those odd jobs around the house that require carpentry, plumbing or electrical skills. Always handy, he's done a lot of the finishing work that homeownership and home improvement require. "I'm not a golfer, so I've always looked at The Cobb as just a big backyard," he laughs. The fact that Glade is a gated community only added to the allure of a safe place to raise a family.

Mankin says he never envisioned himself retired, but the changes brought about in the coal industry in the past few decades made it easy for him to turn the company he built from the ground up (Mankin Equipment) to his oldest son, Matt, who is now at the helm of Mankin Sales LLC, located in Mt. 
State Championship right here on her home course. She says she loves playing The Cobb, where she shot a 45, her at Pipestem, Big Bend and Stonehaven.





"We use mass colors and accent colors on the borders," says Ronnie. "We look at what has performed well historically, but

> we are always considering different plants. We order plants for next May and summer in early October to make sure we have the best selection and availability. We transition to annuals typically the third week in May."

> "There are some really great natural rock formations that we uncovered by the drainage area at the new security gate," says Donnie. "It has to be maintained, but along with rocks that were incorporated, it really gives a nice golf course feel," adds Ronnie.

> "It's very important when you pull into the community to experience a beautiful entry," says Donnie. "The neighborhood comes alive, and it lifts your spirits. It makes people happy and proud to live at Glade Springs."


