hen Shady Spring High School's standout runner, Charlotte McGinnis, recently signed a letter of intent in a ceremony at the high school to run cross country at Concord University, she neatly closed one chapter of her running life and now stands ready to write the remaining chapters of an already storied career while academically pursuing studies in psychology or sports psychology. CU offers her a chance to run with many of the friends from the area she's made in the sport, including CU Coach Mike Cox. The campus beautiful will also offer her the comfort of being around a couple of her high school buds, all-state volleyball players Meg Williams and Chloe Thompson, both of whom will also be wearing the Mountain Lion maroon and white.

The diminutive spitfire just completed her senior year of cross country with her second straight 3rd place finish in the Class AA Region 3 meet where she and Gwynn led Shady to their first regional title in ten years. Before she began battling the "injury bug," McGinnis had won that same event at the AAA level when she competed for the Flying Eagles of Woodrow, setting her personal best (19:52) on the course at Ona in the MSAC championships as a freshman. Her sophomore season was marred by a nasty ankle sprain suffered just prior to regionals and then she developed a nagging case of Patellofemoral pain syndrome from overuse, and that required some time to heal.

During the interim her family moved back to the Shady district "Playing both sports at Woodrow wasn't really encouraged," she intimated, "so I was glad to have that opportunity again at Shady." She says playing



soccer her junior year allowed her to quickly make friends at her new school. "I really made some great friends among my soccer teammates," she recalls with a sense of gratitude, having played travel soccer since the age of seven. She split time between the striker position and left forward.

With an athletic heritage that goes back to her grandfather, Pat McGinnis, a retired high school basketball coach who also coached cross country at the University of Charleston, Charlotte often does trainingfun runs with her siblings, Gwynn, a freshman at SSHS,





and Shepard, a 6th grader at SSMS. Parents, Courtney and Dr. Matt McGinnis who coached her in middle school, make sure the three harriers also share responsibility for their four dogs: Roma and Java and covid pups Millie and Archie.

The speedy senior admits it has been good to take a breath since her season ended, and she is enjoying a little down time before the holidays. Her favorite relaxations are just hanging out with friends, sleepovers with besties, doing a little shopping at TJ's, and maybe hitting Panera for some mac and cheese w/ bacon. There aren't many places in the home of Rick and Stoya Lay where the couple and their two best buds, wire-fox terriers, Jax and Missy don't have a wonderful view of Lake Chatham. Whether it's sipping a cup of morning joe as a lake breeze readies them for the day's challenges or a quiet glass of wine around one of their several firepits while sunset and shadows reclaim the Chatham waters as their own, the Lays must purposely seek out a place at 195 Winston Place that does not afford them a watery vista.

Perched atop a hill with a lawn that slopes down to the water at the edge of one of Chatham's coves, the multiple level home's earth tones and stone and board and batten siding fit nicely into its surroundings. Having recently completed an addition that includes a new one car garage that also houses a wood workshop, a huge







master bedroom, bath and closets, additional deck space, and a butler's pantry that all came about as Stoya likes to say, "Because Rick wanted a bigger closet." Regardless of the motivation, the additional space added to an already beautiful home, and the residence now checks all their boxes.

Had the cost of those materials not escalated so much during the building stage, that new garage, which was built to accommodate Rick's long-time dream of owning another Porsche 911, would not be housing the couple's golf cart. Nevertheless, the Lays are quite satisfied with the many changes they've made as well as the future possibilities that the new garage now affords them!

nash burgers have become the rage the last few years if you are plugged into Food Networks and other foodie resources. Cindy bought me a Blackstone Grill a couple Father's Days ago and I decided to dive into this smash burger thing! I haven't looked back..... and neither will you if you like a nice diner style burger. Thin. A little crisp sear and your fave condiments. OH MY!!! There are some key tricks of the trade to this and I've done the homework so let me save you the learning curve!!!

INGREDIENTS

- Two pounds of ground beef of your choosing. 80/20 is the popular choice for flavor but if you want a lower fat content that's ok!
- A cast iron skillet on your stove or Blackstone grill or cast iron plate on your gas grill.
- Extra Light olive oil.
- A wide spatula or burger press.
- A ¹/₂ cup measuring cup with a handle.
- Black pepper and Kosher salt.



RESIDENT RECIPE



- Deli sliced cheese of your choice from your favorite deli/ grocery store. (PLEASE DON'T USE THE PREPACKAGED STUFF IF YOU WANT CHEESE ON THIS BURGER!
- Hot mitt(s)
- Pan / Cookie sheet
- Tin foil
- This makes 8 burgers. GREAT LEFTOVERS or great as tacos/ nachos, etc.
- Your favorite burger roll!

DIRECTIONS

1. LOOSELY put the ground meat in the ¹/₂ measuring cup as loose as possible without falling apart on the tray. Just firm enough to not fall apart. DON'T roll them around in your hands like a ball like we all have been taught/done!


2. Get your cast iron skillet as hot as can be with the extra light oil. (Xtra has a higher burn point- important!)

3. When the skillet/Blackstone is hot....place the meat balls on the skillet / grill.

4. Fold a piece of tin foil to fit your spatula / press device. 5. In the same order you put them down, press them down with your press/spatula and HOLD DOWN FOR 10 SECONDS! Important! Creates the sear. This is the only time you press/ smash. Don't do it twice.

6. Flip in order and season with salt and pepper

- 7. Depending on your doneness preference.
- Flip and cheese until melted.
- 8. Enjoy with your favorite condiments and nice roll!






