It is a skill she acquired during the dark days of isolation during the pandemic. No idle hands here!



Since their acquisition of the property, the pair have completed multiple updates to the home including the additional garage and deck expansion. Total, the







About the only other problem Zegna has is a





Dena Cushman | Executive Director | Beckley Area Foundation

ot all heroes wear capes, but they all have one thing in common: they strive to make the community we live in a V better place for future generations. It is precisely this kind of philanthropic ambition that makes the work of Dena Cushman and the Beckley Area Foundation so extraordinary. The Foundation consists of six (6) employees: three (3) part time and three (3) full time, with Cushman as Executive Director at the helm of operations. But the foundations work is nothing short of a group effort. According to Dena, "we are able to do what we do because of our many endowments established by donors throughout the years," and all those who continue to contribute to its success.

The Beckley Area Foundation has been serving the Raleigh County community since 1985, funding an array of charitable organizations, providing scholarships for youth and other worthy projects. Since its inception, the Foundation has distributed nearly \$22 million back to the community, with \$1.5 million solely in the last year (April 2022-March 2023)—an amazing

accomplishment. Cushman came to the Beckley Area Foundation in 2001, serving initially as Chief Financial Officer before rising to the position of Executive Director in 2017. A position that is fast paced, and ever changing. With the recent completion of the scholarship cycle, the office is currently switching gears and beginning to focus on the various grant programs that are available to the community. Though every day is different, some daily responsibilities include handling the contributions that come in and meeting with donors.

There are a multitude of grants offered through the Beckley Area Foundation. Of interest is the Community Grant Program, which allows qualifying applicants to request up to \$7,000 annually for projects which benefit the under-served residents of Raleigh County in areas of economic development and education, among others. The deadline for this specific grant program is November 30, 2023. Another series of grants offered include the Field of Interest Grants which provide more tailored projects. This could be in any specific field, but currently these grants include but are not limited to: music education, educator training, environmental preservation, arts education and more. The application for these grants are open from May 15 through June 15, 2023 and are open to non-Raleigh County non-profits as well. Currently, there are over fivehundred (500) endowments which provide scholarships and support a multitude of non-profits in the community through grants provided by the Foundation.

Dena came to West Virginia by way of Wisconsin in 1987 and completed her bachelor's degree at Concord University. Prior to her time at BAF, Dena worked at the YMCA as their Business Service Director and Financial Officer. In addition to her work at BAF, Dena is a member of the Quota Club of Beckley, Beckley Rotary Club and serves as a member on the board for Philanthropy WV and Charitable Gift Planners of WV. When asked what her favorite thing about her role at BAF is, Dena cited, "helping donors meet their philanthropic goals and working with area non-profits." When asked which project she felt especially passionate about, Cushman responded, "The Susan Landis Youth Philanthropist Program," which started shortly after Landis' retirement in 2017. The

two-year program is open to High School Juniors and Seniors and incorporates project-based learning programs utilizing the Three Pillars of Philanthropy: fund raising, charitable giving and service projects. The program accepts up to twenty (20) Junior students and is a means in which they can give back to their community. Within the program exists its own grant program which the Senior students complete the fundraising that goes towards the Junior's grant making to area non-profits.

As members of the Raleigh County and Glade Springs Community, we are honored to support and recognize these individuals and their benevolent contribution to our community. Especially neighbors like Dena, who are truly making a difference.
