



GSVPOA TRAIL PASSES & MORE!

We have our **2023 trail pass** available for purchase at this time. This year the board has approved a single combined trail pass for both Stonehaven and Woodhaven. The fee is \$600 plus tax. This will also include one GHIN membership with additional

memberships available for \$34 each plus tax. There will no longer be separate Stonehaven and Woodhaven trail passes. The Golf Committee will be adding member events throughout the summer to encourage play on Woodhaven. For example, when a trail pass holder plays at Woodhaven, they have complimentary use of the POA carts, if needed. Previously, when we have mixed course events such as Member/Member or GSVPOA Club Championship, members with a trail pass to Stonehaven only, they would have to pay for their cart fee(s) on the Woodhaven course. This fee will be included for the 2023 combined trail pass.

We also have a couple of new options for the upcoming golf season. We will be offering prepaid discounted passes for member cart fees and prepaid guest of member green fees that include cart fees. We will have a punch card that will be sold that includes 10 fees, prepaid, and get two free. This pass will only be valid for the 2023 season and will expire on Dec. 31, 2023. The unused will not roll over to the 2024 season. All passes can be purchased at the Woodhaven golf shop or the Stonehaven Starter House. During inclement weather, please call ahead for availability. In addition, we are now allowing private carts without a POA trail pass to be used on our courses, providing the member pays the applicable cart fee.

For those POA members that are interested in taking advantage of booking online, please email matt.felber@ gladespringspoa.com or tyler.farley@ gladespringspoa.com and we will reset your online access and update your username and password. This will be a great opportunity as we are soon to install our new point of sale system that will allow you the option to pay at the tee, via your phone, and avoid any lines in the golf shop for payment of cart fees



and/or guest fees if applicable. The new system has many additional functions that will be integrated as we bring it online.

"One Call Does No All""

cott and Karen Berneburg did not have a direct route to the nest they have made at 113 Glenhue Lane, but for all the twists, turns and challenges they endured to get there, they are happier than they have ever been. 



and spread out evenly. Melt butter and pour evenly over bread. Sprinkle with cinnamon. Sprinkle with 1/2 of raisins. Mix eggs, cream, sugar (monk fruit) and vanilla with an electric mixer until frothy (3-5 minutes). Pour into the pan evenly over the bread. Sprinkle remaining raisins over top. Set another 9-by-13 pan or a cookie sheet on top of bread pan with weight to force bread down into mixture and let soak for at least 10 minutes. Bake at 325 Ffor 60 minutes. Serve warm or room temperature with whipped cream or

HISTORY

Bread pudding has the most plebeian of origins, but it now shows up on the dessert menus of upscale restaurants.

Food historians trace the history of bread pudding to the early 11th and 12th centuries, as frugal cooks looked for ways to use stale, leftover bread instead of letting it go to waste. In 13th century England, bread pudding was known as "poor man's pudding," as it was a popular dish with the lower classes.

Basically, the dish is made by layering bits of bread and any add-ins in a dish and pouring a custard sauce over before baking. The possibilities for the dish are endless because cooks can vary the type of bread and any ingredients they choose to add.

Monk fruit has been grown in southern China for hundreds of years. It's small, melon-like fruit and gets its name from the Buddhist monks who originally grew it centuries ago.

Monk fruit is also known as Swingle fruit (Siraitia grosvenorii) or lo han guo. It's from the same food family as gourds, like pumpkin and melon. It's been used for medical purposes in eastern countries to treat intestinal problems and the common cold. Its use as a sweetener is fairly new.






