If you have ever had the pleasure of playing a round of golf with Dwight Smith and his merry band of golf buddies, you will understand that each time I see these guys zipping around one of our courses I conjure up images of Spanky and Our Gang. If

you aren't old enough to remember this cast of children from the early days of black and white tv, go to Youtube and meet a group of young miscreants so ornery and fun-loving that they continually walked the razor's edge between good fun and acceptable behavior and having to cut a switch for their own punishment. Smith's motley crew of linksters usually consists of Doug Amstberg, Bob Butsch, Steve Mahoney, Dave Pack, Pat Starrett, and occasionally a straggler like me or Coburn.

Thin skinned golfers need not tee off with this rambunctious group. The needling starts on the practice green and doesn't relent until the final putt is holed. Certain protocols govern play, chief among them is ready golf. You had better be ready to hit your shot when it is your turn or even before that! These boys are going to finish their round in less than 4 hours, in fact 3 hours or 3.5 is the goal, whether they're playing a foursome, fivesome, or more. All are accomplished golfers. Some days they play better than others, but even when they play poorly, they play fast. If you need complete quiet before hitting a shot, you are in the wrong company. The ability to stay focused is paramount because laughter, jokes, and stories are

constant, sometimes even in midswing, but never with the goal of making you hit a poor shot. They're just entertaining themselves.

The game's traditions and codes of behavior are safe in this group. It's all good and no one gets upset or takes anything personally. It's just part of the fun and pace. It isn't unusual to hear the click of 3 well-struck iron shots all while drawing a single breath. Weather permitting, this group plays Woodhaven six days per week, but you will never see Smith don a toboggan or cap. His perfectly coiffed "do" has withstood snow, wind, rain, as well as sun. When Woodhaven is closed, they bring their merriment to Stonehaven.


While all take turns instigating the fun and the ribbing, Smith is chief among them when it comes to stewardship of the game and our courses. Divots are replaced, bunkers are raked, ball marks are repaired, all the while keeping up the pace of play. He came to golf as a young adult at the old Twin Oaks course (now Daniels Vineyards) in Crab Orchard playing with a set of clubs he purchased for \$50. When that course closed for good, he graduated to Grandview where he learned the responsibilities and skills of good golf from some of the better players in the area: Ira Lee, Jeff Davis, Wheel Thomas, Jimmy Jones, and Eddie Jenkins. Those competitive "cat" games at Grandview were conducted with honor and fierceness, teaching Smith to be a gentleman golfer, respectful of the rules and responsibilities of the game.

In those days the Grandview gang kept their skills sharp during the winter months with trips to Myrtle Beach, Santee, and Columbia, South Carolina. Many of the members of the group were government employees so their golf junkets were usually





scheduled around federal holidays, especially Presidents' Day. When it was too cold to play in Beckley, they'd head to "Little Miami," as they liked to call Willow Wood. "Hinton was always 10 degrees warmer than Beckley," he recently recalled. Smith has 6 aces in his career and believes he is the only person to have aced #9 at Grandview twice.



With so many memorable shots to his credit, Smith said his favorite came on #17 of the Cobb during the Justice Cup. He and partner Dave McClure came to the par 3 one down in their match vs a team from the Sporting Club and with the Glade Team one down overall in the matches. He aced the hardest par 3 on any of the Glade properties to help win the match and tie the Justice Cup.

Smith attended Concord University where he majored in biology and math while lettering as a member of the Mountain Lions' bowling team. Today he is as adept on the lanes as he is on the links. After graduation, Smith, at the recommendation of his father, the postmaster in Smith's hometown of Sophia, took the civil service test. It turned out to be good advice. He retired from the United States Postal Service at the age of 55 after 32 years of service most of which was in management. He is proud that during that tenure he served 29 years without an absence, managing at times as many as 400 postal staff and dealing with seven different unions simultaneously.

Smith reflects on his career affectionately. "Folks forget that the USPS was founded as a service. It wasn't started as a business that needed to make a profit." After retirement from the USPS, he worked several years for his pal Dave McClure at Highland, now Apex Towers.

The two have put together numerous golf trips to Ireland and Scotland for friends. "Those courses are very beautiful and tough, but really we're spoiled here at Glade. Stonehaven is so beautiful, and Woodhaven is aesthetic as well and requires such precision. I still love the traditional design of the Cobb and those huge greens,"


he reflects. Among the gems he's played across the pond are Royal Port Rush, Royal County Downe, Carnoustie, Kings Barn, Royal Dornoch, and Troon.

It doesn't matter if Dwight Smith is teeing it up on a local nine-holer, one of Glade's three beauties, or on a world-famous golf property. You can bet there will be good golf played. The course and playing partners will be respected amid plenty of laughter. Most importantly ready golf will be played. The pace will be brisk, but not so fast as to rumple the hair.

Greek Marinated Grilled Lamb SUBMITTED BY KRISTINA KILLEN Chops

LAMB CHOPS

- 3 racks of lamb chop (usually I just get one rack at Sam's and it will serve three people comfortably)
- 1/2 cup olive oil
- Three minced cloves garlic
- 1 teaspoon of Dijon mustard
- 2 tablespoons of fresh chopped parsley
- \bullet 2 tablespoons fresh thyme
- Juice from half a lemon
- 2 teaspoons fresh ground pepper
- Salt and fresh ground pepper
- Dried oregano

INSTRUCTIONS

This is a perfect spring dish and easily prepared. I have also made some finishing salt to sprinkle on the lamb. I used a lemon finishing salt with these lamb chops. Simple to make: zest of 1 lemon and 1 cup fleur de sel. (Be careful not to over salt your meat). You will place this in a 200° oven on a sheet pan with parchment paper. Make sure you spread out the mixture evenly. Bake until the lemon is dried out. I will then put this in a spice grinder and grind to the consistency I like. You can add all kinds of things to your salts like thyme and rosemary. Simple and easy to do and so much less expensive than the ones you buy in the store and better tasting. You can use any kind of citrus for this salt recipe.

I will usually go ahead and break down the rack of lamb into chops and then marinate. A lot of times I will marinate overnight if time allows. You will want to cook your lamb about medium and this goes quite quickly on your grill. Make sure you reserve some marinade to place on the lamb chops to serve. Usually, I will serve with the lamb a nice tossed green salad, or roasted\ grilled vegetables. Also goes well with a cauliflower



purée or mashed potatoes. In the picture I made a pea and leek risotto which was also well paired.

Use a shallow glass baking dish, add all the marinade ingredients (olive oil, garlic, mustard, parsley, thyme, lemon juice, and black pepper) and stir to blend or place in a ziplock bag to marinade. Make sure to reserve 1/3 of marinade for finishing the lamb chops. Marinade 2-4 hrs or overnight.

After you have marinated the lamb, bring out of the refrigerator and let come to room temperature. At this time season the lamb with salt.

Next Preheat the gas grill or charcoal grill to medium heat. Depending on thickness, grill your lamb chops for about 3 minutes on each side. Brush the remainder 1/3 marinade reserve onto lamb chops after grilling and then sprinkle with flour de seal and finish with some dried Greek oregano.




