It has been said that one of the great things about living in the United States is that it is the land of second chances. Four years ago, I penned a story for what was then Glade Living about a courageous young lady who had stared down her own mortality, having battled cancer, and who had finally been given a clean bill of health and a second chance at living life to the fullest. Abby Bailey is still making the most of those opportunities.

When our readers first met Abby, she was a freshman, excited to enter her first year of high school, having spent a year home schooling while trying to get healthy. Today she's still a freshman, but now about to begin her second semester at WVU Tech where she is pursuing a degree in nursing with an eye toward eventually becoming a nurse practitioner specializing in the field of cosmetic health.

On holidays and extended breaks from classes, she still works in her father's dental office, but since summer the petite bundle of energy has had a second focus beyond being a successful student. "In June I decided I wanted to take my fitness to another level," she recently told me after finishing a session at Performance Fitness with her trainer Courtney Hosch. "My goal is to gain weight, the right kind."

She hits the gym hard up to four days a week and at least one of those is with Courtney who devises the day's plan to meet Abby's overall goal. On the day I caught up with her she had just finished a back and full body workout. She usually gets her cardio on the stepper, but large muscle groups are the targets on days when she is doing bench presses, leg presses, the Arnold press, and chin ups. Her core work (abs) will

usually incorporate "suit cases" and sit ups. Combo workouts include thrusters where she is doing squats while pushing a weight overhead.

She says that while some exercises are focused on a particular area, most incorporate a lot of push or pull so all parts of the body are being used. Having a trainer ensures proper technique and accountability. Her favorite lifts are back squats and anything that works her abdominals. She says her most challenging exercises are one-leg RDL (dead lift) exercises.

Complementing her fitness regimen is diet. "I eat a lot of protein, mostly steak and broccoli. I love ovenroasted broccoli," she confesses. It isn't unusual for her to go through two heads of the green vegetable in a week. Her mornings get started with a protein (kachava) shake.

Abby isn't a big believer in New Year's resolutions but among her specific goals for 2024 is to squat 100 pounds by this summer. Smart betters who take one look into those beautiful, steely eyes will take the over on that one!







ne should not be surprised to learn that the Memorial Garden located behind the eighteenth green of Stonehaven was precipitated by the loss of a golf buddy. The garden, now over a decade removed from that initial conversation between John Callender and Dave Swanson where the two discussed the recent passing of their neighbor, friend, and golf companion Paul Grygiel, continues to remind us to enjoy each round and the quality relationships that are often built through the game.

The two were inspired by the bench placed atop the hill between #13 and #14 Stonehaven by Max Scott in honor of his wife and walking buddy who often paused at that very spot to admire the beauty around them and perhaps to even catch their collective breaths. The more Callender and Swanson brainstormed, the closer they moved to making the project a reality.

Initially their idea was rejected by resort leadership as they sought permission to do something on the Cobb course. The superintendent there said it would create more maintenance. Resort leadership countered that they didn't want a graveyard in the middle of his golf course, but the two movers and shakers were not easily deterred.

A plaque was ordered, monies secured via donations from other golfing friends, and Callender located the perfect rock in the woods of Woodhaven on which to attach the plaque, and since they had decided to place the memorial on the Grygiel property adjacent to #7 green at Stonehaven, permission to complete the task became a moot point. To this day golfers slowing down to cross the street on the way to the 8th tee drive right past the memorial. Mrs. Grygiel does the maintenance, keeping the area around the marker always looking sharp. Leftover money from the first plaque was used to purchase golf balls for the Woodrow Wilson golf team where Paul Grygiel once served as head coach.

Currently there are fifteen plaques displayed in the garden and the driving force behind each one usually comes from one of the following weekly golf groups: the



Cameron group, the Woolwine-Fulbright group, or the Clayton Terry group. The Terry group often has a few dollars left over from their game each week and those dollars act as seed money for any future memorials. Callendar remains in charge of procuring plaques, thus standardizing their size, appearance, and costs. He also designed and built the bases on which they are

Callender says the current location has worked well. "Rennie Hill, long before he served on the POA board, came up with the location, and the way we have it set up allows family and friends to visit without being in harm's way and getting hit by an errant shot, and it doesn't disrupt other golfers. There is a bench where one can sit and reflect. The landscaping (rocks and plants) requires little if any maintenance and is pleasing to the eye," he states.

displayed. Dave Gruver now handles all the money.


Because most agree that the current area has reached its maximum occupancy, future memorials will require expansion into the wooded area to the right of the cart path that circles the garden.

Callender said plans are already underway to ensure that future golf buddies will be remembered with the same class, dignity, and accessibility that their predecessors have been and notes that since the POA boards have been made up of residents that each board has been very supportive with only one requirement. Anyone who is being memorialized must be a member in good standing!

What began as a simple gesture of friendship by two golf buddies has made a real difference in the lives of many Glade residents who have lost loved ones.



# **DIRECTIONS**


- 1. Remove membrane from ribs (a butter knife under the membrane and pull with a paper towel)
