
Brandon sheepishly admits. Although the golf is somewhat restricted by the working and the coaching, he still manages to get out whenever he can.




DAVID HEGELE IS all the above, in spades. The Shady Spring High School senior is one busy young man, whether he is playing center-back (defense) for the 5-1 Shady soccer team, splashing his way to the wall in the 100-meter backstroke, or trying to break the 2-minute mark in the 800 meters at a Shady track meet.

The average high schooler might claim to be overworked just trying to meet the demands of three sports but throw in an academic workload that includes AP literature, AP calculus, AP chemistry, and AP government and you have a recipe for a busy senior year, especially when you learn that he is carrying a 4.6 GPA!

In addition, David is an accomplished musician (a member of the SSHS band) and is recognized as one of the best euphonium players in West Virginia. A euphonium is a smaller version of a tuba that produces a sound similar to that made by a French horn.

As president of the SSHS National Honor Society, David has led NHS student-community projects such as cleaning up the grounds at Little Beaver State Park prior to a Tiger cross country meet, sponsoring a toy drive to benefit underprivileged children through the local Toys for Tots program, or heading up multiple fundraising projects that will benefit student scholarships through the Beckley Area Foundation. 





■f you were at a recent meeting of the Glade Springs Preservation Association held at the Glade Springs Community Church you heard a brief oral history of Glade Springs as recalled by local resident John Stroud. According to Stroud, Glade Springs has had several owners since its establishment in the early 1970s by the Caperton family of Slab Fork Coal Company. The presentation took those present from those early days through several bankruptcies up to the current owners of Glade Springs Resort.

Certainly, every owner/investor in Glade Springs has had an impact on this wonderful place we now call home. Beginning with a nine-hole golf course and a clubhouse, tennis facility, pool, and a restaurant it has evolved into a full-fledged resort with a hotel and conference center, 3 golf courses, 2 pools, a spa, a freshwater lake, multiple restaurants, and enough amenities to keep us all entertained.

All growth is accompanied by growing pains and Glade Springs has not been spared in that regard.

Most recently those pains came about when several of our neighbors thought that the business of the property owner's association needed to be conducted according to state laws that govern unincorporated communities like ours, and in a transparent manner. The bright future that lies ahead for the residents of Glade Springs is owed in great part to those early organizers who decided to make a difference.

John Stroud, John Slack, Tommy Woolwine, David Ramella and Jack Spencer in 2018 formed the Glade Springs Preservation Association. Those early organizers rolled up their sleeves, put in countless hours researching courthouse documents and financial records, and enlisted the help of their neighbors in a struggle that has culminated in a bright future for all residents, the Resort, and the POA itself. Backed by the financial contributions of many residents, these difference makers, without the need for litigation, won the right for all property owners to elect the first (not appointed) board of directors, which board eventually resolved many outstanding POA related issues. With substantial contributions and support from Dave McClure, Rick Lay, Paul Myers, Bill Kinder, Dwight Smith, Bob Stalnaker and many others too numerous to mention, our elected POA board has proceeded to conduct the business of the property owners in a lawful and transparent manner.

A tip of the hat to those many difference makers for their many sacrifices that have kept Glade a wonderful place to visit and a beautiful place to call home.

Braised Red Cabbage with Granny Smith Apples!

INGREDIENTS

Yield: 6 to 8 servings

- llarge red cabbage, 2 to $2\frac{1}{2}$ pounds, quartered, cored and cut crosswise in thin strips
- 2tablespoons canola oil
- 1small onion, thinly sliced
- 2tart apples, such as Braeburn or granny smith, peeled, cored and sliced
- About 1/3 cup balsamic vinegar
- ¼teaspoon ground allspice
- freshly ground pepper to taste

PREPERATION

Step 1

Prepare the cabbage, and cover with cold water while you prepare the remaining ingredients. Heat the oil over medium heat in a large, lidded skillet or casserole, and add the onion. Cook, stirring, until just about tender, about three minutes. Add 2 tablespoons of the balsamic vinegar and cook, stirring, until the mixture is golden, about three minutes, then add the apples and stir for two to three minutes.

Step 2


Drain the cabbage and add to the pot. Toss to coat thoroughly, then stir in the allspice, another 2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar, and salt to taste. Toss together. Cover the pot, and cook over low heat for one hour, stirring from time to time. Add freshly ground pepper, taste and adjust salt, and add another tablespoon or two of balsamic vinegar as desired. -Great with grilled bratwurst. Roast pork loin/chops or freshly harvested venison tenderloin. Serve with roast garlic whipped potatoes and a coarse ground mustard.
