s the first Monday of September rolls around each year, Americans eagerly anticipate the long weekend — the last hurrah of summer. It's a time for barbecues, parades and the chance to squeeze in one final vacation before autumn sets in. But how many of us truly understand the origins of this esteemed holiday? Surprisingly, many Americans are unfamiliar with Labor Day's significance. It is a day that not only honors the hardworking individuals who form the backbone of our society but also commemorates the long-fought battles and achievements of the labor movement.

Labor Day has a rich history dating back to the late nineteenth century.

The Industrial Revolution brought about grueling and unsafe working environments for most Americans, including 12-hour days and sevenday workweeks, even for children. In response, labor unions emerged to advocate for better conditions. In 1894, a pivotal moment occurred when employees of the Pullman Palace Car Company in Chicago went on strike, sparking a nationwide boycott. On June 28, 1894, President Grover



granted, and for Hank and Laurie Sammons of 217 Hawks Chase Lane, its a notion personified. The Sammons are a 'perfectly imperfect' couple, who met while vacationing at the same condominium in Estero, FL. The pair were both widowed and met unexpectedly while patronizing the condo coffee shop. From there came lunch, which turned into wine at a beach club, followed by dinner and finally, dancing until midnight at the Fort Meyers Music Walk. Since that time, the Sammons have never stopped dancing. Their courtship lasted six (6) months and the pair ultimately wed at their home in Glade Springs on August 10, 2013 in a private ceremony surrounded by family.

hey say life is something you should never take for However, prior to their serendipitous meeting, Hank, an orthodontist from Huntington, West Virginia, and Laurie, an educator, author, and national consultant from North Dakota, lived in a sense, parallel lives.

> Following his departure from dental school, Hank married his first wife, Elizabeth and settled in Huntington where he ran a successful orthodontist practice. At the age of twenty one (21), Elizabeth was diagnosed with stage I Hodgkins Disease and due to radiation treatments was unable to conceive children. Together, Elizabeth and Hank adopted two (2) children: Maggie and Drew.

Hank participated in an annual father/son golf tournament which initially brought him to Glade Springs.



Though in subsequent years, he also came to the resort to play in the annual Chatham Cup. In 2004, Hank purchased the property on Hawks Chase Lane and began construction on the family's lake home—the third (3rd) home to be built on the lake. Later, family friends, Cuffy York and Rick Flowers would also purchase homes in Glade Springs after being introduced by Hank. For seven (7) years, the couple enjoyed weekends and holidays on the water at Chatham before Elizabeth succumbed to heart failure as a result of her Hodgkins radiation treatment.

Meanwhile, Laurie, (then Robinson), and her husband, Neil wereanticipating the celebration of their thirty seventh (37th) wedding anniversary in the Galapagos Islands. The celebration was bittersweet as the couple had recently suffered the loss of three (3) close immediate family members in the weeks prior. By day the pair climbed mountains, took hikes and went deep sea diving. One evening, in reflection of their recent losses, Neil stated that he would depart a happy man if he were to die today and jokingly, he indicated that, "If I could choose a way to die, it would be quickly and with a basketball in my hands." Three (3) weeks later, Neil's premonition came true after he suffered a massive heart attack at age fifty six (56) while playing basketball. Together, Laurie and Neil shared three (3) children: Aaron, Heather and Carson.

Loss is something that has profoundly affected both Laurie and Hank, though it is through loss that we begin to see how truly beautiful life is and garner a deeper appreciation for the present. A motto mounted on their living room wall, "Accept what is, let go of what was, have faith in what will be," stands as a testament to how the pair live their life each day with God and family firmly in the center. The couple are members of the Glade Community Church.

Together, they share five (5) children and seventeen (17) grandchildren ranging in ages from two (2) to eighteen (18). Recently, their many loved ones shared a

week together at the Sammons home fishing, boating and spending quality

time together. They also enjoyed laser tag and inflatable soccer among other activities offered at the Glade Springs Recreation Center. But their favorite parts of the area include nature, tranquility, and friendly, down-to-earth

but she is excited for her next big adventure at Shady Middle School.





It's All About the View!



If I were to call good friends John and Pat Lostetter visionaries, one might think I was just poking fun, but should one examine the home they have carved out of the forest at 1337 Lake Drive, one might justify the label. The 3800 square foot stucco two-story is nestled back from the street on a wooded lot that affords them privacy on three sides yet opens in the back to a majestic view of Glade gorge below. That is where their favorite



"room" in the house is situated. It is on their patio where they eat most of their

meals, entertain guests, and wind down after a busy day of Glade living, which for them probably includes some gardening and landscaping.

The stone patio stretches nearly the breadth of the home, appointed elegantly with planters full of yellow daisies, petunias, cone flowers, butterfly bushes, and alyssum. More of the same flowers with assists from boxwood hedges frame the patio walls. A few paces down through the plush bluegrass lawn and one finds John's prize koi pond. 
Giant oaks, maples, birches, and white pines intermingle with the only tree species that wasn't already on the property when they moved into their new home in 2004. Above there is a deer-horn chandelier, and of course one wall features a big screen tv.

The master bathroom with its jetted tub, heated floor, skylight, and ceiling to tub windows also provides her a private vanity, insuring she doesn't have to share sink space with hubby John. In some cases, the insurance company will pay for the care initially and then do a post-payment review and take money back for the care if there are not specific reasons or detailed instability tests described in the prescribing physician's progress notes. It's very frustrating and costly for us when this occurs but our focus is on doing the best job, we can with improving the quality of life of our patients. We do our best to work through the challenges."
